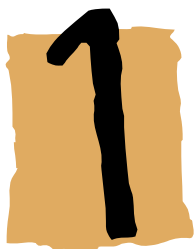


Prioritizing Your School Health Index Data

- Will the administration allow us to do this?
- Do we have, or can we get the resources we need?
