

Second Chance Program Student Assent



Script to be given to students and read to students prior to participating in the Second Chance program:

You have been referred to participate in the Second Chance web-based tobacco education program. The goals of Second Chance are:

- Increase knowledge of the compliance with tobacco-free school policy and community-based tobacco laws
- Increase awareness about the benefits of not using tobacco
- Increase awareness about skills and strategies that can be used to resist health risk behaviors
- Increase interest in quitting or reducing tobacco use

Second Chance is a self-directed online program. It will take approximately 1 ½ - 2 hours to complete. There are three sections within the program – Community, School, and Home. At the end of each section you have the option on continuing to the next section or logging out and continuing at a later time.

You will be asked to complete a survey to find out about your experience and knowledge regarding:

- School and community tobacco laws
- Tobacco industry advertising tactics
- Social norms and perceptions of tobacco use
- Current and future tobacco use
- Resources to help you resist or quit using tobacco

Once you start the survey, you must answer each question and complete the entire survey. Please answer each question as honestly as you can. There are no right or wrong answers, only true answers for you. All information collected will be kept confidential and your name will be erased from the database within one year.

Participation in the Second Chance program is completely voluntary. Parent permission is required in order for you to participate.
