<b>Tobacco-Free Schools Policy Checklist Training</b>	<p>The Tobacco-Free Schools Policy Checklist was developed by STEPP as a tool to assess school district policy content, communication, enforcement, and the district's success in creating a supportive tobacco-free environment. This training provides instruction on how districts can use the checklist to assess their current tobacco policy and develop action plans to improve or enhance their existing policy and implementation practices.
