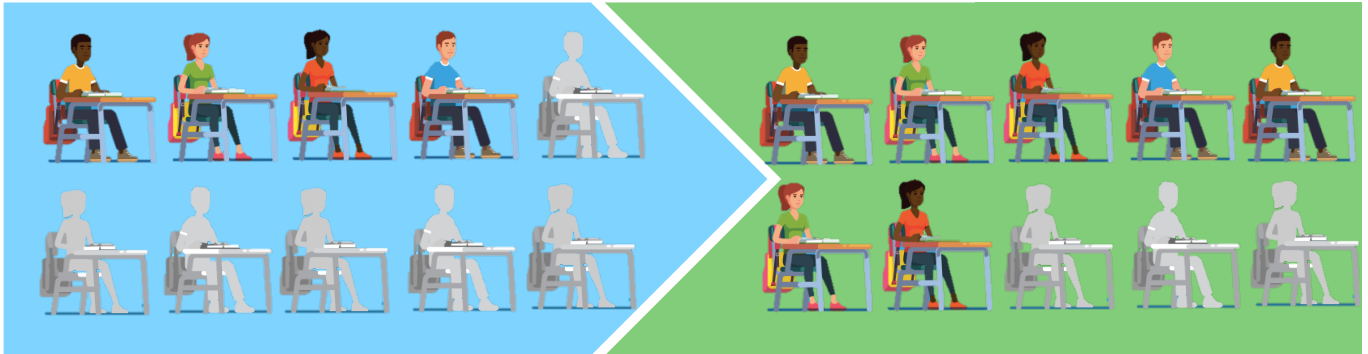


SECOND CHANCE

2018-2019 EVALUATION RESULTS

Funded by the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment's State Tobacco Education & Prevention Partnership and managed by RMC Health, Second Chance is a free, online, educational alternative to suspension for middle and high school youth who violate tobacco policy at school or law in the community. Second Chance is designed to increase knowledge about law & health effects of tobacco and nicotine use, increase skills to resist tobacco and nicotine, and increase motivation to quit.

PERCEPTION OF HARM

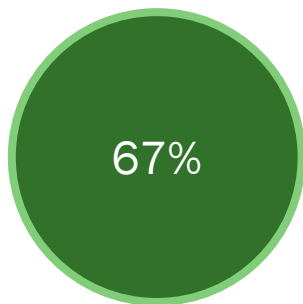


Before completing Second Chance, 35% of participants thought using electronic nicotine devices was unsafe and 40% thought using cigarettes was unsafe.

After completing Second Chance, 65% of participants thought using electronic nicotine devices was unsafe and 66% thought using cigarettes was unsafe.



Before completing Second Chance, 58% of participants felt prepared to resist tobacco/nicotine products.



After completing Second Chance, 67% of participants felt prepared to resist tobacco/nicotine products.

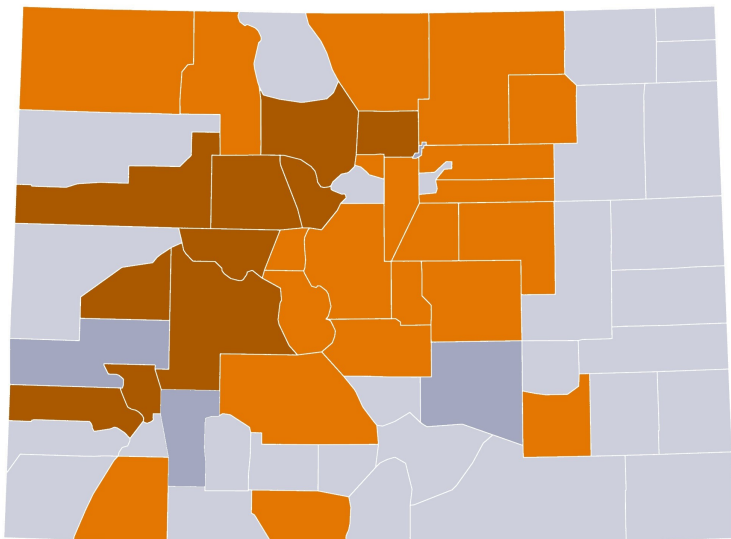

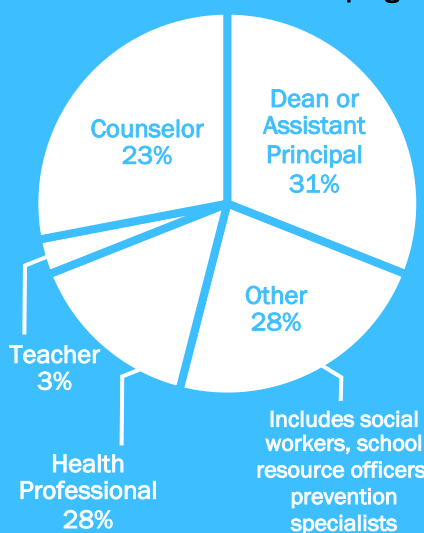
